- The batter must now keep both feet in the batter's box throughout their at-bat.
- If the batter steps out of the box, they are considered to have left the box and can be called out for either a strike or an out, depending on the situation.

### **Sliding Rules:**

- The runner must now slide into bases with both feet first.
- If the runner slides feet first and makes contact with the ground before the fielder, the runner is safe.
- If the runner slides feet first and makes contact with the ground after the fielder, the runner is out.

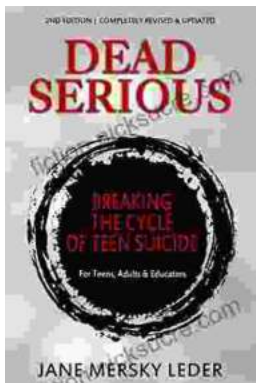
