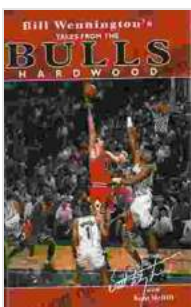


Bill Wennington: Tales From The Bulls Hardwood

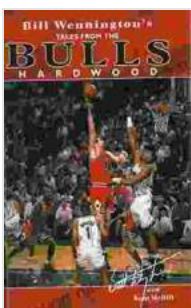

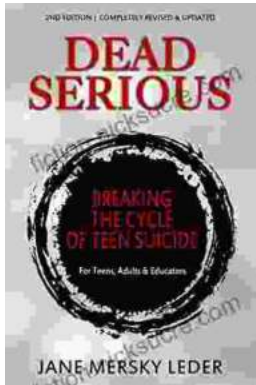

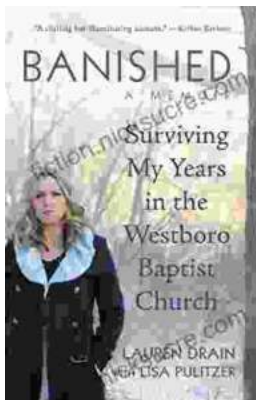
